Presenting the Gospel

Writing Assignment

For this writing assignment you will write the meaning of the gospel (please listen to the audio for this week first). Write as though you are talking with someone and they are interested in the gospel but have never heard of it. So please explain your terminology and be simple. Please write at least 1 page but not more than 5 pages (single spaced, 12 font, Times New Roman. Also write name and date).

For this assignment, you must include <u>ALL</u> of the following things in your paper (however it does NOT have to be in this order):

- 1. **Sin**: what it is, where did it originate from, consequences of sin
- 2. **Humans**: where we came from, our condition after sin, our relationship with God (after fall)
- 3. **Old Testament:** sacrifice for sin, purpose of law, breaking of the law, promise of a Savior.
- 4. **God**: the gift of God, God's love for people, God's hate for sin
- 5. **Jesus:** Who He is, how He came to this world, how He died, what is importance of His blood, meaning of His death and resurrection.
- 6. **Salvation**: how does one become saved (what we must do), what we are saved from, outcome of rejecting salvation

For this assignment, please use Bible verses (but try NOT to write the whole verse but just the passage; for example, don't write "For God so loved..." but only write John 3:16. This way our papers are not too long). Also I encourage you to use other material as well, such as books, articles, websites, sermons. If you do use a material please cite this (no formal citation needed, just basic info). If you do bring other material, try to paraphrase in your own words instead of coping and pasting. If you are stuck on a certain point or not sure what to write about a certain subject, please reach out to me. Don't worry too much about punctuation. Remember their will be no exam for this week, and this will be the only assignment. It is due Wednesday 11:59. God bless!
